The crop of new seed is small, and holders are asking much higher prices than dealers are warranted in paying for old seed. The highest price offered is \$5 a bushel. Timothy is quiet and unchanged at \$4 a cental, and Flax seed is inactive at \$3 a cental.

Wood-Continues inactive at previous quotations. For round lots of fleece 30c to 30lc would be paid, but there is little offering. Supers are steady at 29c to 30lc, and extra at 35c to 364c.
