

THE DOUBLE EVENT TO SWEET COLLEEN

Armine, Favorite, Runs Second in Feature at Windsor—Handicap to Waterbass.

WINDSOR, July 19.—The track dried out rapidly since Saturday and was in good shape for the fifth day's races of the Windsor Jockey Club here this afternoon.

The weather was cloudy but cool, and attendance about 6000. The running of the first half of the Windsor Double Event for Canadian bred 2-year-olds, the fourth number, was the feature of today's card. Jos. E. Segrain's Sweet Colleen, making her first start since the spring meeting at Woodbine, made a show of her field, and led by a wide gap through the stretch, where the later starters, but raced around Billy Frew and Good Shot entering the stretch, and was an easy second. Gladday, from a poor beginning, finished gamely, and beat Billy Frew for third.

In the Belle Isle Handicap Waterbass trailed his field to the far turn. He then moved up via the overland route and drew away easily in the stretch. Burnegat followed the pace of The Widow Moon to the stretch, where the latter weakened, and Burnegat got second without difficulty. The Widow hung on long enough to save third. Bob Hensley was under restraint practically through the stretch, but never making a move on him. Tactics could never get up. Summary:

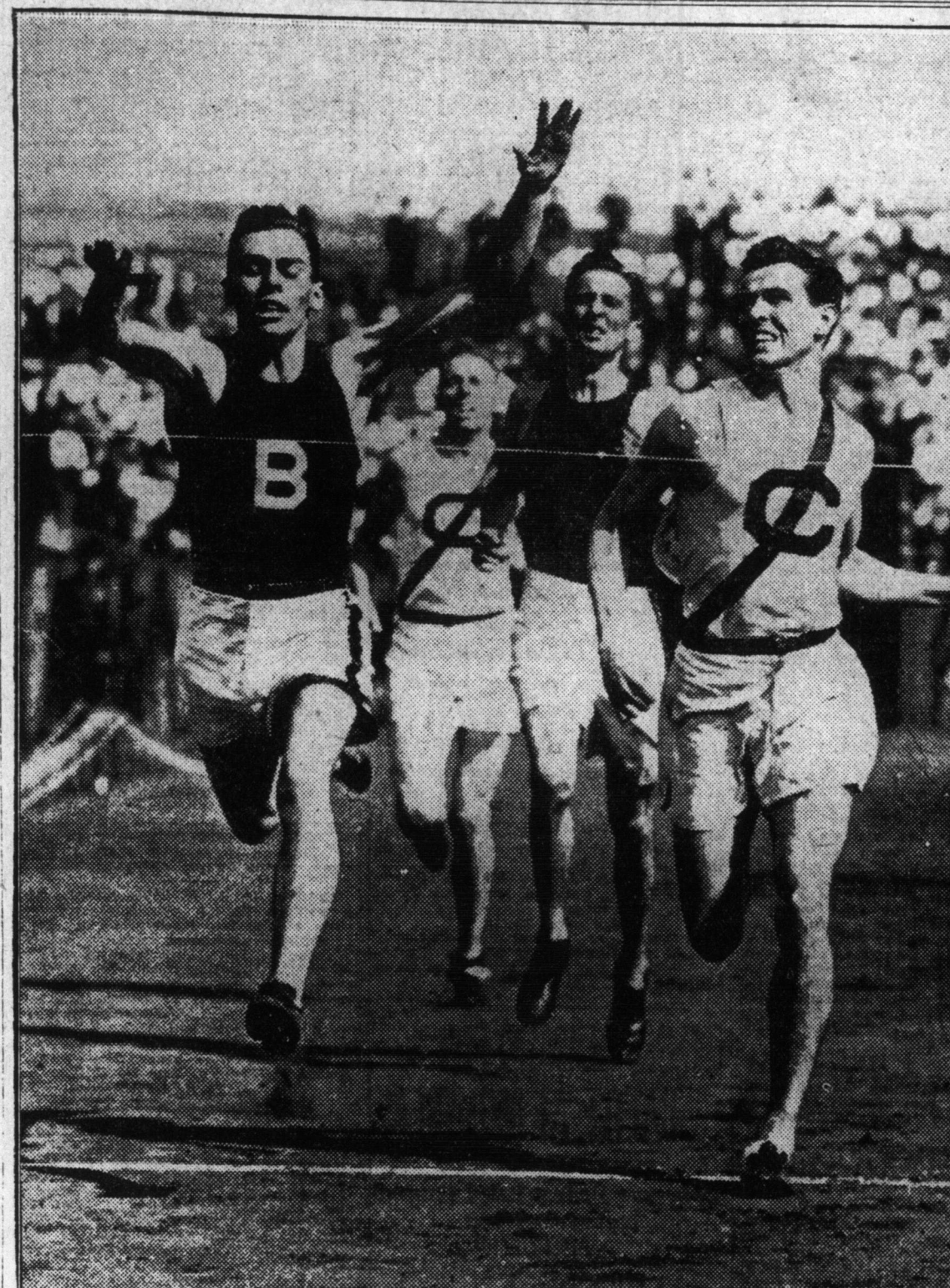
