From Fort Simpson. 818 miles north of Winnipeg by latitude, Ladoga wheat has been obtained which weighed  $62\frac{1}{2}$  pounds per bushel. A small percentage of the grain was, however, injured by frost. The wheat was sown on June 7, and harvested September 22, giving a growing period of 107 days. This is the farthest point north from

which samples of wheat have been received at Ottawa. Wheat ranges in Eurasia to 63½ degrees north latitude. The accompanying map shows the Siberian province of Tobolsk, which in 1900 yielded 6,480,000 bushels of wheat. There is thus evidence that there are possibilities of the extension of wheat acreage in Canada's northern latitudes.
