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- (d) Business from Committees.
- (e) Nominations for Office and for Committees.
- (f) New Business
- (g) Notice of Motion.
- (h) Roll Call.
- (i) Elections and Appointments for Offices, Committees, Public Debates, and Prize Speakers and Readers.
- 5. The order of business at Public Meetings shall be as follows:
 - (a) Essay or Inaugural Address.
 - (b) English Readings.
 - (c) Debate.

But this order may be varied by selections from the Glee Club at the discretion of the General Committee.

- 6. The order of business at the Annual Meeting shall be as follows:
 - (a) Minutes read, approved, and signed.
 - (b) Roll Call.
 - (c) Reports of General Committee and Treasurer.
 - (d) Reports of Special Committees.
 - (e) Business arising out of the Minutes.
 - (f) Election of Officers.
 - 7. All Essayists, Readers and Debaters for Ordinary Meetings shall be chosen in turn from the number of those who have paid their fees for the current year.
 - 8. No member entitled to wear a gown shall speak or vote unless in academic costume. No membe, shall speak or vote after the third Ordinary Meeting of the Society till he has paid his fees for the year.
 - 9. Every member in speaking shall address the Chair, confine himself to the subject under discussion, and avoid personalities and indecorous language.
