## SECTION 3

Government Payment of terest

At the last Session of the Legislature it was Rahway In-ascertained that the Government had paid out of the Provincial Treasury the sum of \$316,-016.80 for interest on the bonds of the Pacific Great Eastern Railway Company,

> I'he reason the Bondholders called on the Government was that the Railway Company had made default owing to:

> > The giving away of its shares; 1.

The misapplication of the monies 2. raised on the Government Guaranteed Securities.

Honest enforcement of existing Statute Law would have protected the Province. The overriding of Public Statute by secret Order-in-Council has occasioned loss to the Province.

I am invoking the aid of the Supreme Court to secure replacement of this money. No argument being possible on the facts, I am charged with tying-up the affairs of the Province.
