About 7 o'clock the sisters arose and prepared breakfast for themselves, after which Mrs. James Banks returned to her home near by, leaving the deceased alone in the house in her usual health.

About 12 o'clock her sister again returned to the house, and finding the doors open, and not seeing Mrs. Banks, became frightened and returned for her husband, who upon going up stairs found his sister-in-law hanging from the balustrade. She had been dead some time when discovered.

The deceased was 35 years of age, an exceptionally handsome woman, and had been married about 14 years and had no children. Her maiden name was Maria Bennett, her father being employed in the Michigan Central shops at St. Thomas.

Some years ago burglars broke into the house and stole some money and other valuables. Ever, since the deceased has been very timid about being left alone and this, with her delicate health, is the only thing which can be ascribed by the relatives for her rash act.
