Much of the success of the school is, we believe, due to the faithful and zealous efforts of our estimable Superintendent, Miss Forrest, who has by her firm and judicious managment of the children, done much towards laying in them the foundation of an enduring Christian character.

And now in entering on another year let our watch-word be "All that Thou commandest us, we will do, and whithersoever Thou sendest us we will go;" then can we confidently look forward to a year of abundant blessing and unqualified success.
