#### RECENT DEATHS

**Louis Patrick O'Hara.**  
The death occurred yesterday of Louis Patrick, the infant son of Mr. and Mrs. Francis O'Hara, aged three months, at his parents' home, 30 Castle street.

**William McConnell.**  
Less than a month after the death of his father, who passed away here under sad circumstances on June 22, William McConnell died suddenly yesterday in Boston. Word to this effect was received by his brothers here and the body is being sent on for burial, which will take place today from Chamberlain's at 3 o'clock.

It will be remembered that William H. McConnell, the father, fell into the waters of the harbor last month and died two days later. The news of the son's death, therefore, is a great shock. Mr. McConnell was forty-eight years of age and left St. John twenty-five years ago, being since then engaged in the dry goods business. Four brothers survive—John and Harry, of this city; Joseph, of Sydney, and James, of Boston; also three sisters—Mrs. J. B. Leck, Mrs. Charles Knodell and Mrs. John R. Sharpe, all of this city.

**John Ahearn.**  
Halifax, July 19—John Ahearn, aged ninety-two years, passed away at his home, 124 North street, last night. Mr. Ahearn was a veteran both of the Crimean war and the Indian Mutiny and to his last days was able to talk in a most interesting manner of those events.

**Madeline Brewer.**  
Fredericton, N. B., July 19—Madeline, the two-year-old daughter of Councillor Thomas Brewer, of Hawkeham, died this morning from the effects of poisoning. It seems that while playing about the house last yesterday afternoon the child came across some liquid fly poison and swallowed a portion of it. She, at once, became violently ill.

**Rev. J. E. Brown.**  
Rev. J. Eastburn Brown, for many years rector of St. Paul's Reformed Episcopal church in Moncton, died yesterday at Coal Branch where he had been living since his retirement from the ministry eight years ago. He was eighty-four years of age. During his active ministry he was a prominent figure in religious and temperance circles.
