Your flat may be a \$60 month home, but if you don't say so in your ad. the \$60 a month tenant may not reply, thinking perhaps it is a \$15 a month flat.

To get the right tenant quickly, give full information. To rent a room quickly to the right kind of a roomer, give all particulars. Show that you are anxious to make

the roomer comfortable for a reasonable rental. If you wish to sell anything, do not omit the good selling points. It is far more economical to spend an extra few cents and make the sale, rather than to save a few cents in the cost of the ad. and make

no sale. A special rate covers both morning and evening papers.
The rate for your "Want Ad."
