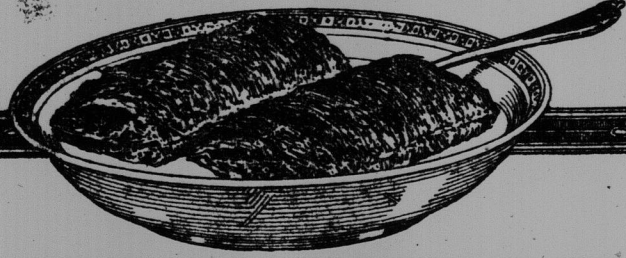

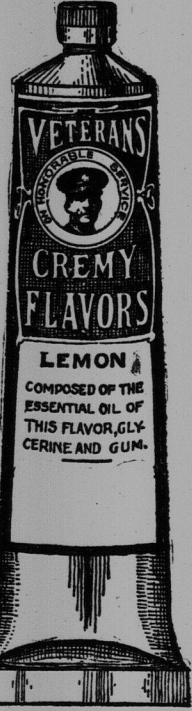

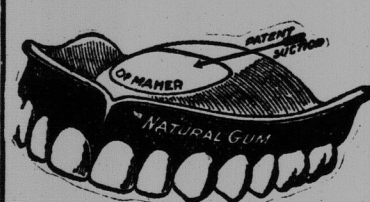

Sackville, N. B., June 15.—At yesterday morning's session of the Methodist Conference it was reported that Rev. George Steel had been elected delegate on the third ballot to attend the ecumenical conference in London. Alternates were Rev. G. M. Young and Rev. F. A. Wightman.

The matter of basis of the payment of the expenses of delegates was referred to a special committee. A report of the laymen's association was submitted by C. A. Sampson. A discussion took place over an item in regard to making semi-independent circuits mission circuits. This passed by a large majority.

Rev. J. Henney presented the report of the committee on systematic beneficences. The report passed. The following were recommended as a committee to carry out the orders of the report:—Ministers—Jacob Henney, A. D. McCully, F. A. Wightman, H. S. B. Strathairn, W. G. Watson, A. C. Bell, G. F. Glendenning, E. Stiles. Laymen—E. R. Machum, G. J. Bradley, J. A. Waters, J. J. Watling, G. L. Moore, Alex. Curran, Henry Smith, D. A. Fickering.

Rev. Dr. Burns of the department of finance, and Rev. S. W. Falls, book steward, addressed the conference.

AGED FARMER IN NOVA SCOTIA ENDS HIS LIFE.

Amherst, N. S., June 15.—At Oxford Junction yesterday, near his own farm, Sydney Purdy was found dead in the river with a heavy chain around his neck. It is thought he intended to hang himself from the bridge, but it is supposed the chain unhooked and let him down into the water, which was only five or six feet deep. He had not been very well of late. He was one of the best known farmers in the county, was seventy years of age and is survived by his wife and a daughter.
