RALPH CONNOR'S NEW STORY

A story in which the reader sees one after another of the intensely interesting characters with whom he or she has come acquainted pass to rest beneath a little wood cross in Flanders fields or on the Somme is true to life as Ralph Connor wrote it in the last few years. His latest novel, "The Sky Pilot in No Man's Land," begins on the banks of the Athabasca River, in the wilds of the north in England; but the action of the story is chiefly in France and Flanders. The Sky Pilot and his battalion were in the types of the terrible and bloody memory, and later on the Somme. It is a fascinating story, and from the moment he is set revealed, taking a plunge from a rock into an Athabasca pool, until the shattered remnant of his battalion lay his young body to rest in the cemetery near Albert, after he had given his life to shield a soldier, the Sky Pilot proves himself a noble and satisfying character, rising to higher planes of vision and radiating ennobling influences among the men who at first look at him as a mere soldier, and later on as a hero. A thread of beautiful romance runs through the book, developed under the extraordinary conditions of the war, but it is like everything else in the war, falls under the shadow and leaves but a blessed memory to soothe an anguished heart. There will be a great demand for this new story by the gifted preacher and novelist, made larger because so many have come into personal touch with him during the war period. The book is published by McClelland, Goodchild and Stewart, Toronto, price \$1.50.
