### ABSTRACT OF THE REPORT OF THE AGENT OF THE SABBATH SCHOOL UNION.

The Agent reports that there are 21 Schools in connection with 16 Churches of the Denomination, leaving about 30 of the Churches yet unengaged in this good work. Some of whom have, however, promised to commence in it on their return from the Association.

Of these 21 Schools, the Agent has been able to get particular
