Some time ago a deputation from the Six Nations Council waited on you at Ottawa and among other things talked of, you informed the delegates that the N.E.Co. had returned the Institute lot to the Six Nations but that the N.E.Co. would only take charge of the Indian girls and that the Six Nations Council would have to make some arrangements to take care of the boys. Now in making this statement the delegates had nothing to show that this was the stand taken by the N.E.Co. and the Chiefs therefore directed that I communicate with you and ascertain if this be a fact.
