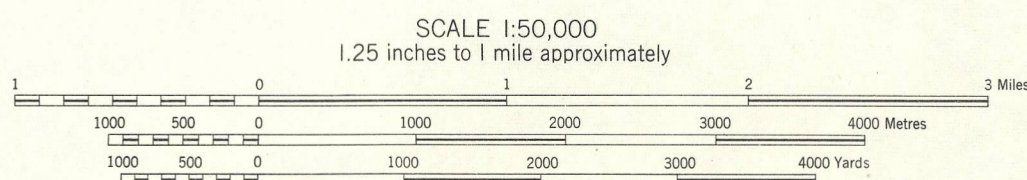

Annual magnetic change 3'30" easterly

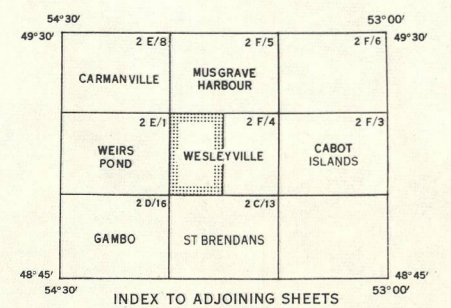
