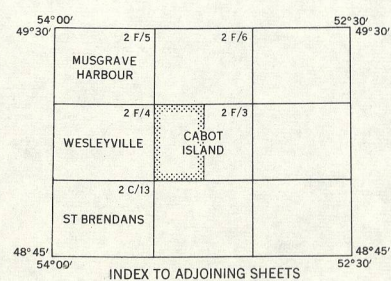

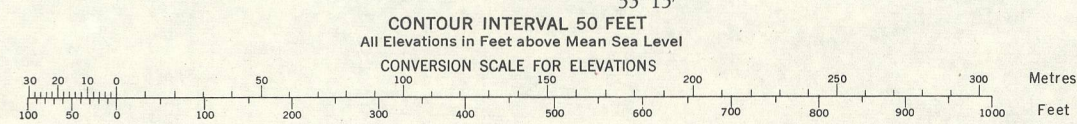
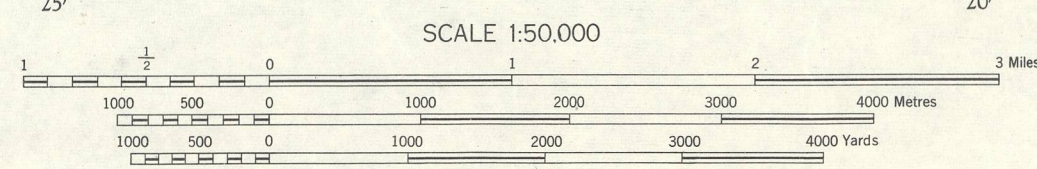


MAGNETIC DECLINATION 30°34' WEST,
