



New York, May 19—Revenue cutter Seneca reports: "May 13, 3 p. m., lat 44 13, lon 48 51, found berg seen April 13 in lat 44 36, lon 48 09; the berg is drifting south 16 deg, east true; six miles in last 24 hours."

Stmr. Fagersand (Nor) reports May 11, lat 37 29, lon 75 02 W, passed a large black buoy with flat top.

Stmr. Esparta (Br) reports May 7, lat 24 26 N, lon 81 22 W, passed a plece of timbe-a shout, 30 feet long and 1½ feet square; same date, lat 24 37, lon 81 02, three pieces of timber of similar dimensions.
