I am directed by the Governor General to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 18th Inst. Reporting upon claim of John Elliott to a share of the Annuity paid to the Scugog Indians, and the circumstances under which he & his family removed to Owens Sound, and in reply to inform you that H. Exy. sees no objection, to a fair portion of the above annuity being paid to those of the Band who settled at Owens Sound in the way you represent.

But I am to draw your attention to the concluding paragraph of my letter of the 13th Inst. which appears to have escaped your observation, & on which your report is requested.
