

CONCEPT OF UN OPERATIONS AT SARAJEVO AIRPORT

- PHASE 1 ○ Sixty UN military observers are deployed to Sarajevo to:
- verify that an effective and durable peace has been established, and
 - supervise the withdrawal of anti-aircraft and other heavy weapons.
- Technical personnel, possibly including international experts, would undertake an evaluation of:
- the airport's servicability,
 - the condition of airport equipment, and
 - measures required to receive aircraft, offload stores and control the flow of humanitarian aid.
- PHASE 2 ○ The Canadian infantry battalion would be deployed to form the core of the force maintaining the security of the airport and its installations. Deployment could be temporary, pending the arrival of additional UN forces.
- PHASE 3 ○ Civilian personnel required to operate the airport and representatives of humanitarian agencies would arrive.
- PHASE 4 ○ Sarajevo airport would open for humanitarian and official flights under the exclusive authority of the United Nations.
