

Lake 15 April 1828.

Sir,
 You will be pleased to suspend the Execution of the Order annexed to you in my letter of the 12 inst: directing you to repair to the Grand River to make the payments to the Six Nations. The Commander of the Force appearing to be of Opinion, as it has been so long delayed, that it had now better be carried into effect, under my orders and in my presence.

You will here find as to have every thing in readiness on my arrival in Upper Canada for which I cannot yet with certainty name a day, not having perfectly recovered from a slight indisposition which has confined me for some time past.
