Accident caused by heavy snow on aerodrome. Pilot R74046, Sgt. Harris, P.A. making instrument take-off was uninjured. Categorized C. 1/2.	
	10-2-42		Harvard 2650 damaged at 1315 hours on main aerodrome, No. 1 S.F.T.S. The pilot Aus. 411742, LAC, Campbell, K.G. was uninjured. Cause was attributed to soft snow on aerodrome causing wheel to sink while taxiing and aircraft went up on nose. Categorized C. 1/2.
