ARRANGEMENTS FOR CONVENIENCE  
OF GUESTS

1. Visitors are advised to arrive at the London Terminal Aerodrome, Croydon, before 2.30 p.m. The journey by road from any of the Thames bridges (Chelsea, Westminster, etc.) takes about 45 minutes, but the time can be shortened by avoiding the main bus and tram routes out of London.
2. The diagram printed on the cover of this Programme shows the route to be taken by cars. After setting down guests in front of the Customs Office cars will be parked in an enclosure on the west side of Plough Lane. After the Inspection guests are advised to leave the aerodrome by the same route.
3. The diagram also shows the position of the exhibition hangar, the light aeroplane garage and the Trust House Hotel, in which tea will be served at the conclusion of the Inspection to visitors and representatives of the Press.
4. Six officers of the Royal Air Force, who will wear brassards, will act as Guides to visitors.
