Ottawa, 26th March, 1912.

Gentlemen,-

I beg to say that the Department accepts your tender to supply for \$439.25 all the band instruments required by the Indians of Sarnia. It is understood that you will furnish brass instead of silver-plated trombones. The instruments should be sent to Sarnia bedressed to Mr. R. C. Palmer, Indian Agent. Your account should also be sent to him to be certified before it is transmitted to the Department for payment. Payment will be made when the Department receives a report to the effect that the Indians are satisfied with the instruments.
