With further reference to your letter of June 6th, I beg to advise that the subject in question was discussed with Mr. D. E. McTaggart, Corporation Counsel and other city officials on August 19th, the Department was represented by the Indian Commissioner and the local Indian Agent Mr. F.J.C. Ball.

As a result of the conference with the city officials they promised to submit certain proposals for the consideration of the Department. We are still awaiting receipt of these before reporting fully on the matter. Mr. McTaggart explained at the time, that some weeks would be required before all the information necessary could be assembled by the city departments involved for submission with his own recommendations to the Council, but that the matter would be given the earliest possible attention. The city's taxation department informed me a few days ago that the city's proposals would be ready for submission shortly.
