Superior are places sacred to Nanibojo. Here are Nanibojo's ware-house, his slide, his leap, his garden, his chair, his farm, his clock and finally his tomb. This is the famous Thunder Cape, which, from one point of view, looks like a sleeping giant reclining upon his side. The mystery of the Manitou fills this whole region, and he who visits the Soo or the north shore of Lake Superior should be familiar with Longfellow's great poem if he would appreciate the charm of the great lake region in its vastness and solitude and power.
