A RURAL DELIVERY BRANCH

An Act was passed creating a new branch within the Post Office Depart-ment, under which the system of rural mail delivery now in operation will be improved and extended. The officer be given charge of this important work will have the standing of a deputy minister. Special officers are to be detailed to amend old routes where necessary and to lay out new ones. Steps are to be taken to have regissteps are to be taken to have regis-tered mail delivered to the rural boxes, and carriers will be supplied with books of stamps. It is not con-sidered practicable to make the money order and postal system a travelling one. As explained by the Postmaster General to the House, it is the intention to cautiously increase the rural delivery service as the business of the country expands . A

THE LIVE STOCK PEDIGREE ACT

A new measure was passed to take the place of the one enacted in 1901 under which all record associations in Canada are incorporated. The new measure is more definite than its predecessor, which was found to be general to work satisfactorily. U tor Under the old measure, associations had no power to spend money except in con-nection with the immediate work of pedigree registration. In order to give grants for prizes at exhibitions, associations were compelled to violate the Act. Under the new measure association may spend this money as they see fit. Under the old act it was difficult to cure conviction and impose fines for

misrepresentation in connection with pedigrees. Under the new measure the Record Committee is entrusted pedigrees. the needed committee is entrustee with this work, relieving record asso-ciations of the necessity of taking ac-tion against their members. EXTEND EXPERIMENTAL FARMS

The policy of extension of the Ex-perimental Farm system, inaugurated perimental Farm system, inaugurated some three years ago, is to be con-tinued. The work of the old estab-lished farms is being extended more expecially in connection with live stock. The newly acquired farms are being thoroughly equipped to do of-fection and corresponding with these fective work corresponding with that done by the older stations. The increased Seed Branch vote is

to be used in connection with field crop and seed grain competitions. Under the old government assistance

Under the old government assistance was rendered through the Seed Com-missioner's Branch by assisting inter-ganizing and advertising the conjecti-tions and frirs and printing the-perts. The prize money had to be provided by the agricultural societies through grants from the Provincial Departments of Agriculture, with the exception of what was given by the Dominion Government for Provincial seed exhibitons. For some provinces this arrangement was apparently sat-isfactory, but for others it was not and the result was the state of the set of t Commissioner for judges did not se-cure any assistance from the Domin-ion Government for this work.
