fuant to an A& passed in the first year of his present Majesty's Reign, Chapter third. was further continued until the first day of May, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-three, to which day the duration of the faid A& is limited; Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, confituted and affembled by virtue of and under the authority of an A& paffed in the Parliament of Great-Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act pass-" ed in the fourteenth year of His Maje Ly's Reign, intituled, " An Att for making " more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North Ameand to make further provision for the Government of the faid Province." and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that the said Act, passed in the fifty-seventh year of the Reign of His late Majerry, George the Third, intituled. "An Act to facilitate the Administration of Justice in certain small matters therein-" mentioned, in the Country Parishes," and all matters and things therein mentioned, shall continue to be in force until the first day of May, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-five, and no longer.

An Act to make further provision for the Lieutenant-Governor of this Province, during his residence in this Province.

(22d March, 1823.)

Most Gracious Sovereign,

Preamble.

Whereas Your Majesty's Representative in this Province, the Governor in Chief thereof, hath, by a Message to both Houses of the Provincial Parliament, in the present Session of the same, been graciously pleased to signify that it is expedient to augment the Salary of His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of this Province, to enable him to live in this Province, in a manner becoming the station he holds, and that a suitable residence be found for him; We, Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects the Commons of Your Majesty's Province of Lower-Canada in Provincial Parliament assembled, most humbly beseech Your Majesty, that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great-Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the sourcement year of His Majesty's reign, intituled,"
