Prefs 6, line 3. Leave out “ this Act” and insert “ the offence com-  
“ mitted.”

ORDERED, That the said Amendments be engrossed.

The said Bill was read for a third time.

The Question being put,

Whether this Bill as amended shall pass?

It was Resolved in the Affirmative.

ORDERED, That the Master in Chancery do go down to the Assembly,  
and acquaint that House, that the Legislative Council have passed  
this Bill with several Amendments, to which they desire the con-  
currence of the House of Assembly.
