

GREEK KING AND PREMIER CONFER

Demands of Allies Have Been Probably All Accepted.

London, Sept. 11.—A Reuter's Athens despatch says that Premier Zolotas had another lengthy conference with King Constantine on Sunday afternoon, after which the cabinet met.

In regard to the shots fired in the neighborhood of the French legation, the despatch says that the allies' demands have apparently been fully accepted although nothing has been officially announced.

Wadsworth, inspector of schools, 1871-1905, born 1841, died 1905, who lies near the Becker grave, and Duncan Campbell, 1802-1892, and Major Jno. W. Ryerson, born 1844, drowned near Long Point, 1891, and many others now passing into history. Rain the previous evening gave the grounds a fresh appearance. The weather was ideal and many were out.
