

267 AMERICAN SOLDIERS LOST WHEN TUSCANIA IS TORPEDOED

Transport Ship Sunk off the Coast of Ireland, Majority of Troops Aboard Saved—Ship Manned by British Seamen and Convoys by Warships

Washington, Feb. 7.—The War Department has official advice of the sinking of the steamship Tuscania, with a loss of some 276 United States soldiers. The vessel was torpedoed and sunk on the morning of Feb. 6, 1918, so far as can be ascertained, landed at Buncrana and Larne, Ireland. There was a total of 279 United States troops on this vessel. No names of persons lost have been reported to the war department and no names of persons surviving have been reported. Additional particulars are promised soon as received.

It was announced that the Tuscania was manned by British sailors, with a British naval guard, and was convoyed by British warships.

The disaster was officially announced by the War Department, which had received only meagre advice, without names of survivors or victims.

The department issued this statement: "The War Department has been officially advised that the steamship Tuscania was torpedoed and sunk off the coast of Ireland, on the morning of Feb. 6, 1918, so far as can be ascertained, landed at Buncrana and Larne, Ireland. There was a total of 279 United States troops on this vessel. No names of persons lost have been reported to the war department, and no names of survivors were reported. Additional particulars are promised as soon as received.

Although still hoping for more favorable news, officials feared that the report meant that all except the 1,100 landed had been lost. No further reports were expected to-day.

Where Survivors Landed
Buncrana, at which survivors from the Tuscania were landed, is located on Lough Swilly on the northern coast of Ireland, twelve miles from Londonderry. Lough Swilly is a long narrow bay running in from the Atlantic Ocean.

Larne, at which other survivors were landed, is on the northeast coast of Ireland, 22 miles from Belfast. It is a North

Channel port. The approximate distance between the two ports is 100 miles.

The Tuscania was a British passenger and freight steamship of 14,348 tons gross register. She was built at Glasgow in 1914, and was owned by the Anchor Line. The last report of the Tuscania was on her arrival at an Atlantic port on January 17 last.

Capacity for 4,500 Passengers
She was 567 feet long, with a 66-foot beam, and was equipped to carry 2,500 passengers in cabin and steerage accommodation. The ship had twin screws and a speed of about 18 knots. On several occasions since the war began she was the object of torpedo attacks, but managed to escape through her speed, assisted by defence guns.

For some time the Tuscania has been under charter to the Cunard Line, and she is the fifth big vessel of the Cunard Company lost since the war began.

First U. S. Transport Lost
Although prior to January 1 of the present year there were more than 100,000 American troops in Europe, the Tuscania was the first transport to be torpedoed on the voyage from an American port to France. Several American transports, however, have been torpedoed on the return journey, after having debarked troops.

When the Tuscania was first put into service her accommodations for first cabin passengers, of whom she could carry 350, were sumptuous. It is probable, however, in view of the exigencies of the situation, that the steamer had been stripped of most of her luxurious fittings in order to take as great a number of troops as possible on each voyage.


RECRUITING IN S. AFRICA

TWO OUNCE RATIORS

Washington, Feb. 6.—Two ounce bread ration was ordered by Food Administration to-day for patrons of hotels, restaurants and dining cars. This allowance is about that now observed in England. Not more than two ounces of wheat bread may be served to anyone at any one meal except that when rolls or bread made from corn, oatmeal or bran are served, and when only one kind other than wheat bread is ordered, a portion may consist of four ounces. Rolls may not weigh more than one ounce each.
