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**Discovery of Copper.**  
A large deposit of this valuable metal has been discovered at Gabarons, about twenty miles from South-York, Cape Breton. Operations are being vigorously pushed forward, and a shaft one hundred feet deep is being sunk in the main lode, which is 10 feet wide. The quartz of the ore taken out is equal, if not superior, to that of any of our Newfoundland mines. It is expected that the cargo will be ready for shipment by the time navigation opens in the spring. The facilities for shipping the ore are all that can be desired, as the mine is only 150 yards from the water's edge, where a good substantial wharf may be built and vessels moored and loaded with all safety.
