Increase of Heart Disease.

Increase of Heart Disease. An evil recognized is sometimes half cured; and the intellectual classes, look-ing at figures such as those which Dr. Quain has displayed in his interesting lumician Lectures at the College of Physicians on " Disease of the Walls of the Heart," may well consider the propri-city of attending to the hygiene of their lives, as well as of their houses; and re-member that, to enjoy and benefit by even pure air, soil, and water they must avoid disabiling heart and Drain by incre-sant labours which too often make use-ful lives joyless, and embiliter the harvest-ting of the erop which has been too difgontly sown. These warning figures the total of deaths of males at all ages from heart disease. In Sin increased in mumber from 5,746 in 1851, to 12,428 in 1870. The precentage of deaths from heart disease for 1,000 of population living was 755 between the yeers 1851 and 1875. This integrase, it must be observed too, has taken place wholly in connection with the working years of actual social life. There is no change in the percent-age of deaths from this cause in males made 25 years of age. Between 20 and 15 years of age it.has risen from 553 to 709, and that almost exclusively in males, for there is almost no increase in the per-centage of females dying from heart disease during the twenty-five years of life from 21 to 45. Those figures con-vey their own lesson, and warn us to take a little more care not to kill ourselves for the sake of living.-*British Medical Journal*.
