## New World's Record for Team Trotting.

## Knox's Baseball Club Defeated the Woodstocks Handily.

### KNOX DEFEATED WOODSTOCK.

The Knox baseball team defeated the Woodstocks in a return game at Tecumseh Park on Saturday afternoon by a score of 10 to 6. Knox bunched their errors in the first three innings, and Woodstock piled up a lead of six runs in consequence, but their efforts to score thereafter were in vain. In the third inning Knox landed on Wolf's curves for four straight singles, which, with a base on balls and an error, netted four runs. In the fifth, Campbell drew a pass to first and Gibson followed with a beautiful home run drive to the fence in left center, tying the score. A single, a two-bagger and a sacrifice following yielded two more runs, and the remaining two were added in the eighth. Cook pitched a splendid game, and Woodstock hit him safely in only three innings. In the fifth they obtained two singles and a two-bagger, but were unable to score; the third man to go out being nipped at the plate by O'Dell's pretty throw from center.
