CANADIANS TO ATTEND COMMONWEALTH EDUCATION CONFERENCE

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Paul Martin, announced today the composition of the Canadian Delegation to the Forth Commonwealth Education Conference which will be held in Lagos, Nigeria, from February 26 to March 9, 1968. The Delegation will include representatives of provincial Departments of Education, the university community and organizations concerned with various forms of educational co-operation in the Commonwealth.
