FILING OF OBJECTION TO REPORT OF COMMISSION FOR
ALBERTA

Madam Speaker: It is my duty to inform the House that an objection signed by the Hon. Members for Edmonton-Strathcona, Red Deer, Calgary West, Peace River, Edmonton North, Lethbridge-Foothills, Bow River, Medicine Hat, Crowfoot and Simcoe North has been filed with me pursuant to Section 20 of the Electoral Boundaries Readjustment Act, Chapter E-2, R.S.C., 1970, to the report of the Electoral Boundaries Commission for the Province of Alberta.

If the House agrees, I would suggest that we follow past practice and print the text of the objections as an appendix to this day's *Votes and Proceedings*. Is that agreed?
