PEOPLE OF JAPAN DEEPLY STIRRED

Government Regards Feeling Against United States as Most Dangerous.

TOKIO, April 18.—(Can. Press).—The Japanese Government considers the present anti-Japanese movement in California as most dangerous and is faced with the prospect of placing itself in a most invidious position owing to the unwillingness of the federal government at Washington to intervene and the possibility of introducing counter measures here.

In the event of the passage of the California alien land bill thru both houses of the legislature, Japan will issue an imperial ordinance enforcing the Japanese foreign land ownership bill of 1910 and will apply to the federal government at Washington for permission for the Japanese to be-

come naturalized citizens of the U. S. At the great mass meeting of protest held here last night there was an incident which aroused the Japanese people.

Hot Shot for U. S. M. Miyake, an editor of the Japanese Times, declared that Japan deprecated the constant visits here of American peace apostles when their own country was in urgent need of the principles of justice and humanity.

Other fiery orators insisted that the questions between Japan and America had better be settled now once and for all. Otherwise their constant recurrence would lead at last to the settlement of war.

Twenty thousand persons listened to the remarks of the firebrands, who apparently are engineering a campaign to mold public opinion in Japan.

The foreign land owners measure passed by the Japanese Diet in March, 1910, prohibits foreigners except under certain restrictions, from owning land in Japan and they may not own land at all in Szechuan, Formosa, Hokkaido or the fortified zones. This law has never yet been officially promulgated.

DROP LITERATURE FROM MONUMENT

Militants Spring a New One, But Populace Loses Patience.

LONDON, April 18.—(Can. Press).—Two enterprising militant suffragettes this morning took possession of "the monument," which stands near the northern approach to London Bridge, and commemorates the great fire which destroyed the City of London in 1666.

Ascending to the topmost balcony they displayed two flags and an immense banner in the suffragette colors, on each of which was written in white letters on a black background, "Victory to women."

Having securely fastened the flags to the railings surrounding the balcony, the women locked themselves in, preventing the police from ascending the winding staircase of 345 steps leading to the top.

Then they took up their positions inside the iron cage, erected to prevent suicides, and showered suffragette literature among the thousands of people who gathered at the foot.

For a long time traffic was suspended in the immediate vicinity, which is one of the busiest districts of London. The suffragettes maintained their position on the monument for upward of an hour. While they were "holding the fort" a heavy missile, thrown from the top of the monument, narrowly missed striking a number of spectators.

The police eventually had to regulate the services of a locksmith, who forced the door at the bottom of the shaft with great difficulty.

A force of upwards of one hundred policemen was required to protect the women from the ugly rushes of the angry crowd.

Both the suffragettes were stylishly dressed and appeared to be little concerned by the excitement they had raised. They were released a short time after they reached the police station.

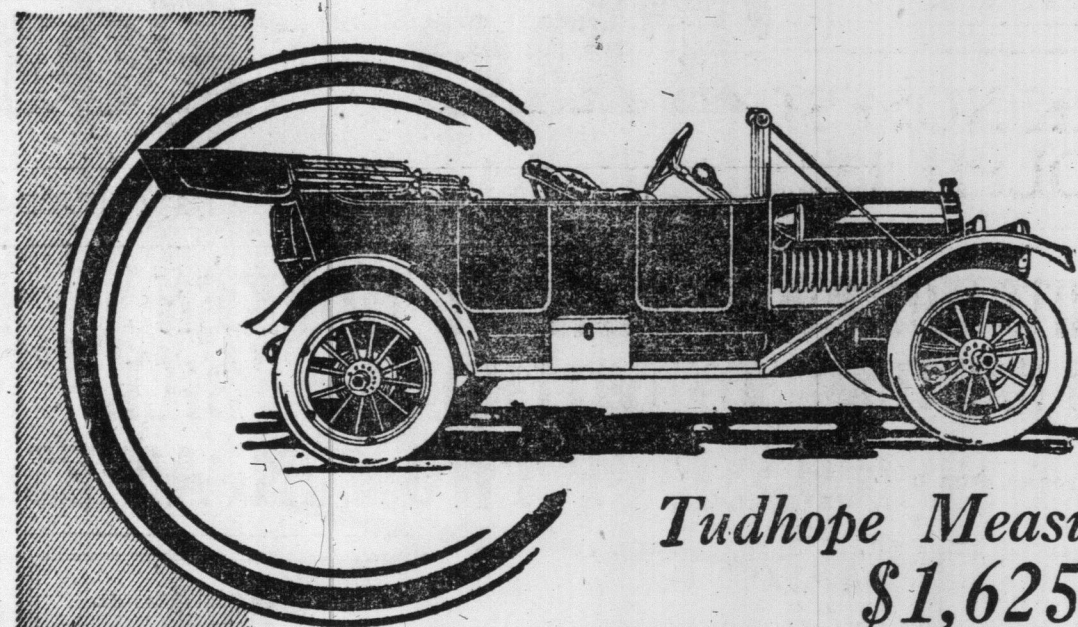

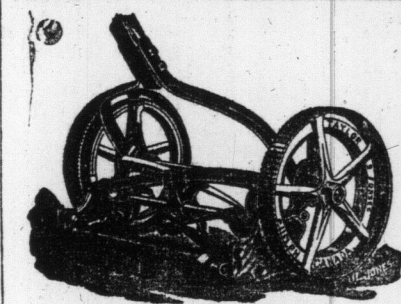

ANOTHER EARTH SLIDE AT CULEBRA.

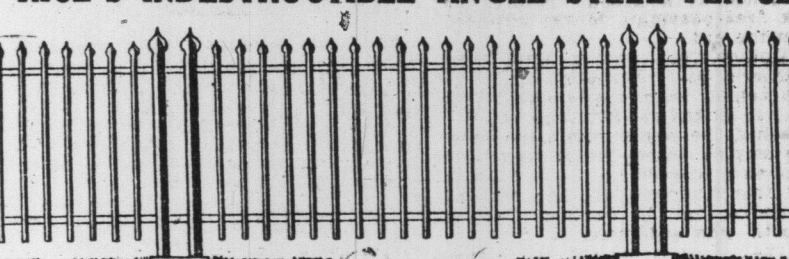
