

I wish to read the statement made by headquarters of the organization at that time regarding the banning of Technocracy in Canada.

"Political Action Against Technocracy in Canada

The defeatist fears of the political forces of Canada have led them to take action against the only organization in that country which will prevent ultimate chaos. Acting under the cloak of wartime necessity, political Canada has moved against Technocracy in an hysterical attempt to block the march of events. The happenings preceding this action are herewith placed on record.

War developments have brought out the following basic features of Technocracy:

That Technocracy is completely North American in its structure and membership, that is, all members in Canada are Canadian citizens, and all members in the United States are United States citizens.

That Technocracy never has had any foreign affiliation or support.

That Technocracy is one hundred per cent opposed to communism, fascism and nazism.

That Technocracy stands for efficiency and is actively on guard against sabotage of all kinds.

That Technocracy stands for the defense of this Continent.
