

PREBROKE.—On 6th, lunar halo. Wind storms, 2nd, 9th, 24th, 9th, 10th, 12th–14th, 16th–18th, 27th. Rain, 24th.
PREFOROUGH.—On 6th, wid distinct halo round moon. 7th, well defined solar halo at 1 P.M. inside of arch of a dull reddish tint. 13th, smoke in dark strata 15th, large solar halo; smokes in large dark strata, passed to southward. 17th, fog shortly after 7 A.M. 29th, at 6.48 A.M. narrow band of blue clog along W.H. and over that a band of bright crimson about 7° in width, very bright. Wind storms, 3rd, 4th, 10th, 24th. Snow, 3rd, 4th, 8th–10th, 13th, 17th, 18th, 26th. Rain, 18th. Month steadily cold until last few days; very little snow fell; fluctuations of barometer remarkable; considerable ranges within 24 hours. On 18th, in fourteen hours the range was 721 (rise).
