

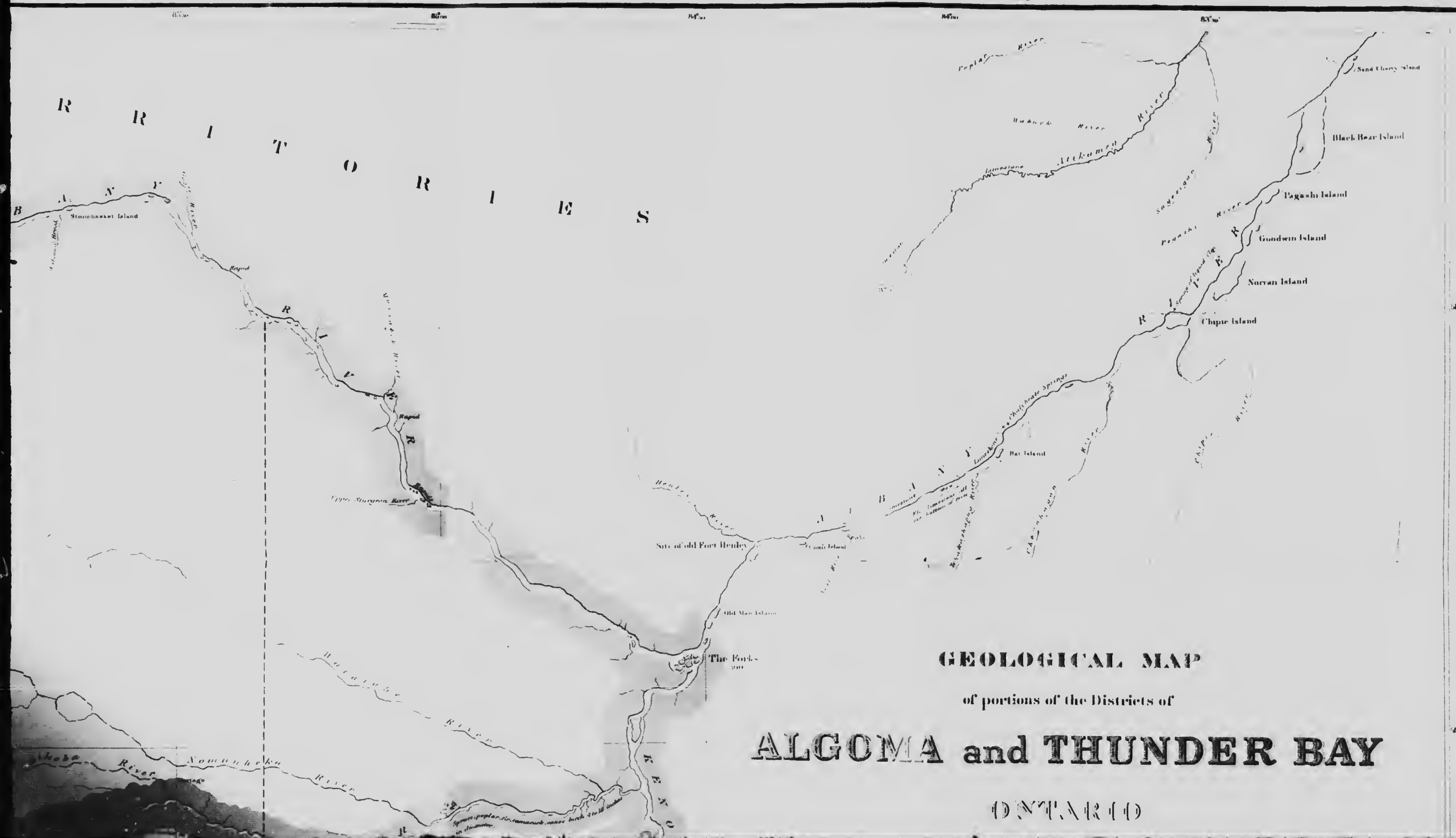

Astronomically checked micrometer surveys of Little Current river and the canoe route from Montserrat C.P.R. to Manitowishaugan via the Nipigon river by W.J. Wilson and O.D. Sullivan, 1903. Micrometer surveys of Nipigon, Nottawegon and Devilfish rivers and the lower portion of the Nottawegon river by W.J. Wilson, 1903. Micrometer surveys of Little Pe river and canoe route to Rabbit Lake, Steel, Black, Pigeon and Grand rivers by W.H. Collins, 1905. Astronomically checked track survey of Drowning river by O.D. Sullivan, 1903.

Astronomically checked micrometer surveys of the Pe river north of Hervey's line, Long Lake, Kenogami and Albany rivers, and the canoe route from the Albany river to Onababika Bay by R. Bell, 1870-71. Track surveys of the Kabinakuyung river, upper portion, Oba river, White river and vicinity, and the group of lakes northwest of Long Lake by R. Bell, 1870 and 1881.

Transit micrometer and log surveys of Lake Nipigon and Nipigon river by D.B. Dowling and William M. Jones, 1894 and 1898. Track surveys of the Little Jackfish, Onaman, and Nipigon rivers by D.B. Dowling, 1898.

Track surveys of the lakes and rivers east and southeast of Lake Nipigon by W.A. Parks, 1901-02.
