- 12. In the event of a dead heat, the same crews shall contest again, after such interval as the Umpire may appoint, or the crew refusing shall be adjudged to have lost the heat.
- entered for any prize, or if more than one enter and all withdraw but one, the remaining crew, by rowing over the course, shall be entitled to the prize.
- 14. An Umpire shall be chosen by the Executive Committee, and his decisions shall be final.
- 15. The Judge at the winning post shall be appointed by the Umpire, and his decisions shall be final as to the order in which the contestants crossed the winning line.
- 16. The laws of boat racing adopted by the National Association, so far as not inconsistent with the Constitution, By-Laws and Regatta Rules of the Association, shall govern at the Regattas.
- 17. The prizes shall be delivered at the conclusion of the Regatta to their respective winners, who, in case of a challenge prize,
