Scholars in Residence.

The Resident Scholars obtain all the advantages of the School, together with the careful nversight and refinement of a Christian lnnme.

The number of Resident Scholars being limited, application for admission in September should be made, (if possible), early in the Summer.

Resident Schnlars entering in September, are not received for less than the schnnl year, except by special arrangement.

For an Entrance Fee of fifteen dollars, each resident scholar will he furnished during the entire time of her residence, with the necessary hedding, towels and table linen; nr if preferred, a charge of twn dollars will be asked for each Term.

Each article of apparel should he distinctly marked with the owner's full name.

Dentistry and Dressmaking cannot he attended to during the pupil's residence at school, except hy special arrangement.

Parents making application for the admission of their daughters as Resident Scholars, are requested to give with the application, at least, two satisfactory references.

Resident and Dan Scholars.

The School Year commences nn or about the 15th of September, and closes nn or about June 20th. It is divided into Four Terms, not Including a firthight's Vacation at Christmas and a week nr ten days at Easter.

Pupils are not expected to remain at the School during the Christmas and Easter Hnlidays, which are not included in the School Year; hut if it is necessary for them to remain, a charge of six dullars a week is made.
