

Scholars in Residence.

The Resident Scholars obtain all the advantages of the School, together with the careful oversight and refinement of a Christian home.

The number of Resident Scholars being limited, *application for admission in September should be made, (if possible), early in the Summer.*

Resident Scholars entering in September, are not received for less than the school year, except by special arrangement.

For an *Entrance Fee* of fifteen dollars, each resident scholar will be furnished during the entire time of her residence, with the necessary bedding, towels and table linen; nor if preferred, a charge of two dollars will be asked for each Term.

Each article of apparel should be distinctly marked with the owner's full name.

Dentistry and Dressmaking cannot be attended to during the pupil's residence at school, except by special arrangement.

Parents making application for the admission of their daughters as Resident Scholars, are requested to give with the application, at least, two satisfactory references.

Resident and Day Scholars.

The School Year commences on or about the 15th of September, and closes on or about June 20th. It is divided into Four Terms, not including a fortnight's Vacation at Christmas and a week or ten days at Easter.

Pupils are not expected to remain at the School during the Christmas and Easter Holidays, which are not included in the School Year; but if it is necessary for them to remain, a charge of six dollars a week is made.
