## FRUITS AND VEGETABLES.

### Rules for Fruit and Vegetables

Competitors for the following prizes must be small growers, exclusively for their own household use, and be engaged in other occupation for their living. Farmers who have regular orchards, persons engaged in fruit growing for commercial purposes, market gardeners, etc., are excluded from competing. In the event of any dispute as to the interpretation of this rule, the matter is to be referred to the Board of Directors, whose decision on all points shall be final.
