SESSION VI.

DIET I.

Kingston, St. Andrew's Church, 14th September, 1836.

After sermon by the Rev. John Cruickshank, Minister of Bytown, Moderator for the preceding year, from John, chap. eighteenth, verse thirty-eight, "Pilate saith unto him, "What is truth?"—the Synod of the Presbyterian Church of Canada, in connection with the Church of Scotland, met in St. Andrew's Church and was constituted with prayer.
