Reference to "Beer-Soaked" Englishmen Raises Storm in London, Ont.

London, Ont., Nov. 6—"I want it thoroughly understood that these statements were made on my knowledge of the truth, and that I stand by them. If I have made a mistake I would have said long before this, I am sorry, I made a mistake, but I did not make a mistake and no one can make me say I have."

Dr. Green said that his sermon, in this connection, had been accurately reported and that he had no apology to offer for the statement.

He pointed out that when the statements were made he was speaking to an Orange congregation, many of whom were Englishmen. He declared he had the Orange ritual before him at the time and noted that it referred to temperance, on which he was speaking in making the statements. He declared it could not be interpreted to mean the English race, but asserted that it certainly did mean those who were "shouting the loudest for government sale" at the meetings here during the plebiscite campaign.

"I am an Englishman myself, but I certainly am not beer-soaked," he declared. "I was not referring to St. George's Society or to the veterans. I am perfectly willing at any time to address the St. George's Society or the Great Way Veterans' Association and give them my stand. I would ask, or course, that they give me a fair hearing."


MOUNT A. VS. U. N. B.
