NEW LABOR CASE

Arrest Two Scotch Workmen. Brought Out Here, and Who Quit Work.

Toronto, Oct. 5.—George Thompson and Alex. MacKenzie were arrested last night on a warrant charging them with "desertion of service." At the request of the Canadian-Band Ingersoll Com-pany, Sherbrooke, the men were arrested. They were engaged in Scotland early last summer and their passage paid to Can-ada. When they arrived in Sherbrooke they found a strike in progress and af-ter working two weeks left the employ of the company.

WAR FUNDS TOTAL LOSS. Announcement has been made of the total loss the steamer War Fundy, built at St. John in 1918 by Grant & Home. She was bound from Blythe, Scotland, with a cargo of coal for Gelle, and went ashore at Grundklesgrund in the Gulf of Bosnia. A wireless mes-sage was sent for help, but the seas were so high that the salvage ship could give no help. The crew of thirty-one men was a ship of 2,268 tons gross and 1,102 tons net.

ARNSTEIN FOR TRIAL. New York, Oct. 4.—Trial of Jules W. (Nicky) Arnstein, charged with grand larceny and receiving stolen property in connection with Wall street bond thefts, was set for October 25, by Jus-tice Mulgrew in the court of general sessions, today.

Arnstein, now in the Ludlow street jail, charged with contempt of court for failing to answer questions in a bank-ruptcy proceeding brought against him. His counsel had demanded that the trial take place at once.
