

LOCAL CHINESE TO TAKE NO PART

Say They Will Not Join
Countrymen in "Hu-
miliation Day."

Chinese in St. John will not join with their countrymen, as those in some other Canadian cities are doing for the observance of July 1 as "Humiliation Day." The day has been named by the Chinese Nationalist League and will be observed annually as a result of offending immigration regulations which require that every person of Chinese origin, regardless of birthplace, age or sex, must report to the immigration officials before June 30 for registration.

Hum Oake, 44 Mill street, said that the local Chinese had complied with the new regulation and almost all had registered and sent in their photos, etc. He said that no objection was taken by the local Chinese to the new immigration law. He added that there were about 110 Chinese in St. John and they were not linked up with any Chinese association.

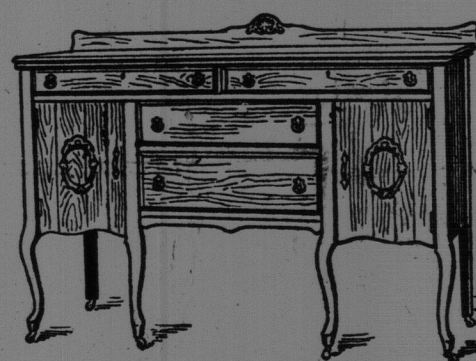
