Cowan, and found him to be deficient of the articles as indicated in the list I am now readin to you, which is marked "D", and annexed hereto, to the value of £3-15-6, which at 75% of the vocabulary price amounts to £2-16-9%, in accordance with C.A.R.O. (0) 1398."

The accused declines to cross-examine this witness.
