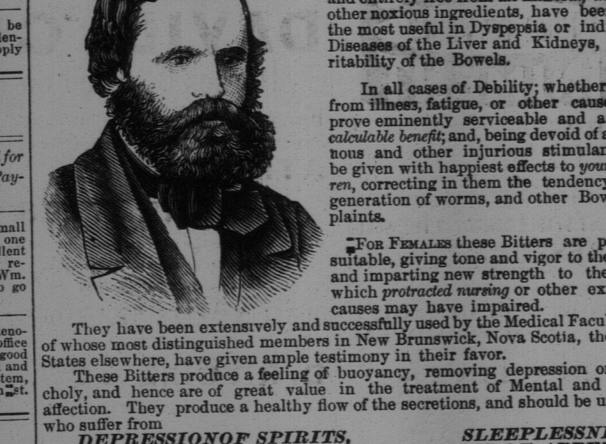

BEATS THE RECORD.

The City of Paris Arrives at New York and Beate on Record. New York, Aug. 28.—The steamship City of Paris arrived this morning. She has broken the record again, having taken less time from Queenstown by three hours and 49 minutes. Her actual time from Queenstown to Sandy Hook Light ship was five days 19 hours 18 minutes. The distance is 2788 miles.
