THE RING FINGER.—Switzerland
finger of the wedding ring is to be
the fourth finger of the left
hand, next to the little finger; because
by the received opinion of the learned
and experienced in ripping up and au-
tomatising men's bodies there is a vein
of blood which passes from the fourth
finger into the heart, called *vena amoris*
(Love's vein); and so the wearing of
the ring on that finger signifies that
the love should not be vain or feigned,
but that as they did give hands each
to the other so likewise they should give
hearts also, wherever they should extend.
Commenting upon this the *Carleton*
Monthly remarks: "This idea
seems to have arisen in Egypt as early
as the second century. Apollon, an Al-
exandrian historian, says that, in the
opinion of the anatomists of Egypt, 'a
certain most delicate nerve passes from
the ring finger to the heart.' But the
staunch upholder of this theory was
Livyus Lemnius, a celebrated sage of
Zealand, who lived in the sixteenth
century. In his medical practice he
had often taken advantage of connecting
theory to reduce fainting women to
consciousness. 'The ring finger,' he
stretched forth from the heart into this
finger, the motion whereby you may per-
ceive evidently in all that affects the
heart in women by the touch of your
finger. I used to raise such as were
fallen into a swoon by pinching this
joint, and by rubbing the ring of the
finger with a little oil, for by this re-
viving force that is in it passes to the
heart, and refresheth the fountain of
life, unto which this finger is joined.
Wherefore anatomy thought fit to com-
pass it about with gold.' He also states
that this finger was termed 'medius
sineus,' if any young man, notice was
given to the heart before it was too late
to use an antidote. The gout also never
afflicted this finger until the attack had
assumed a fatal character. This he
had observed in Gallia Belgica, the land
par excellence of podagral sufferers, no
Belgian, however, would ever permit
his finger to be so abused, for he would
have been ever suffering in this
finger till death was nigh at hand."

PHOTOGRAPHING SEA-DEEP.—
Dr. Newman recently exhibited before
the Berlin Geograph. Soc. Society an ap-
paratus devised and used by him photo-
graphically to determine the temperature
and set of the sea at the bottom of the
sea. The apparatus consists of a
copper box, containing a rudder to be
acted on by the current, and a compass,
and a thermometer. Scattered paper is put
in the box, in such a position that when
light is introduced into the box through
the rudder, compass, needle and mer-
cury column will be thrown on the paper.
When the box reaches the bottom of the
sea and electric current is sent down to
the box to produce sufficient light to act
upon scattered paper and to show the
depth on indicator, the shadows of the
compass, needle, and rudder, when com-
pared, will show the set of the current,
and the shadow of the mercury column
its position at the time light was intro-
duced.
