Mr. Bright had been consulted on the comparative ments of writing and extem-pore speaking, and hereplies:—"Given a man with knowledge of his subject, and a gift for public speaking, then I think reading a mischief; but given a man who knows little, and who has no gift of speaking, then reading seems to be inevitable, because speaking, as I deem it, is impossible. But it must be doem it, is impossible. But it must be a terrible thing to have to read or speak a sermon every week, on the same topic to the same people; terrible to the speaker, and hardly less so to the hearers. Only men of great mind, great knowledge, and great power, can do this with success. I wonder that any man can do it! I often doubt if any man can do it." It is hardly exact, perhaps, to speak of the whole range of othics and religion,—ethics and religion, too, as freely illustrated by the biography and history of one great literature, a range which sermons certainly cover—as a single topic, for these include thousands of very distinct topics.—Spectator. -Spectator.
